Why do we need Officers?

As with any project, there has to be someone in charge, or it's chaos! Officers serve as organizers for the office they are elected for.

This does not mean they do all of the work. As the hands and feet of Jesus, it is the responsibility of everyone to help when they can.

The officers not have ultimate authority over decisions. Everything we do is voted on, which is why attending meetings is so important.

What are the Offices and their Responsibilities?

Each office has a 2-year term, with a term limit of 4-years.

President

The president leads the quarterly meetings and ensures all business is handled between meetings.

The President makes announcements to the church body and gives updates to the Communications Department so information can be included in the monthly newsletter.

Special Events Coordinator

The special events coordinator ensures that each event has all elements covered: decor, food, volunteers.

They do not do all of the work themselves. They communicate with the church secretary to have events included in the church bulletin and the calendar. They post reminders/details on the WOW FB page and the HBC Family FB page. There can be more than one person in this position.

Secretary

The secretary records minutes for each meeting and posts them on the WOW Facebook page so those not in attendance are kept up to date.

The secretary turns announcements in to the church secretary so they can be included in the bulletin.

text and/or email
and vote whether to
approve or deny the
request. This will be
presented by the
president at the next
meeting.

All of these positions are voluntary.

As such, there is flexibility with the term limits.

We understand life happens and you may enter a season where serving is not possible.

That's ok!
Communicate with your
fellow officers and it will
all work out!

Vice-President

The VP is a president-in-training with the expectation they will step into the president position the next election cycle.

The vice-president fills in for the president as needed and organizes the WOW Supper Club.

Treasurer

The treasurer is responsible for reconciling the WOW bank account and reporting on activity at the quarterly meetings. All expenditures are voted on.

The treasurer does not make executive decisions on how funds are used.
